Lessons learnt

To start small and test suitability of the product/market. Also, the company learnt the importance of design, the choice of materials in circularity, as well as the limits of certain designs.

Challenges

The most challenging aspect has been to raise awareness around the company concept and inform people that furniture subscriptions exist. Furthermore, a challenge would be adjusting the product offer to be able to refurbish everything and to be fit for circularity.
